

Materials

- Cover 50 gameboard
- One set of number squares, 2–50, in an envelope or resealable plastic bag

Players: 2, 3, or 4

How to Play

1. Place the gameboard in the center of play. Each player draws ten number squares out of the envelope or bag.
2. Players arrange the number squares face up in front of them. Each player should be able to see everyone's number squares.
3. The player with the smallest number begins. This player calls out any factor.
4. Players search their number squares for numbers that are multiples of the named factor. Players then place these number squares over the same number on the gameboard.
5. Players take turns calling out factors and placing multiples of that factor on the gameboard. The game ends when a player has no more number squares.
