

How Long? How Many?



You need: Cuisenaire Rods

One die

"How Long? How Many?" record sheets

1. Each player uses a different 10-by-10 grid on the record sheet.
2. On your turn roll the die twice. The two numbers give you the dimensions of your rectangle. For example if you roll a 2 and 5. You draw a 2by5 rectangle.
3. Place the rectangle on your grid. Write the multiplication sentence inside.
4. The game is over when one of you can't place your rectangle because there's no room on the grid.
5. Figure out how many of your squares are covered and how many are uncovered. Check each other's answers.
6. Play again.
