

## Number Top-It (3-Place Decimals)

- Materials**
- number cards 0–9 (4 of each)
  - Place-Value Mat for Decimals

**Players** 2 or more

### Directions

This game is played in the same way as *Number Top-It (5-Digit Numbers)*. The only difference is that players use the Place-Value Mat for Decimals.

In each round, players take turns turning over the top card from the deck and placing it on any one of the empty boxes. Each player takes 3 turns and places 3 cards on his or her row of the game mat.

**EXAMPLE** Andy and Barb played *Number Top-It* using the Place-Value Mat for Decimals. Here is the result:

**Place-Value Mat for Decimals**

	Ones	.	Tenths	Hundredths	Thousandths
Andy	0		3	5	0
Barb	0		6	4	2

Barb's number is larger than Andy's number. Barb scores 1 point for the round. Andy scores 2 points.
