

Square Up

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You need: One geoboard
One rubber band
Game markers with holes, 12 each of two colors
Geoboard dot paper

1. Each player uses a different color marker. Take turns placing a marker on a peg of the geoboard. The object is to place four of your color markers to mark the corners of a square.
2. When you think four of your markers mark the corners of a square, say, "Square Up." The other player says, "Prove it." Prove it by stretching a rubber band around the pegs you think are the corners of a square.
3. If a player has made a square, the game is over. If not, keep playing until one player makes a square or all the pegs are covered.
4. When the game is over, record on geoboard dot paper where you each placed your markers. Play again.
